Keynote Speaker

Dipti Itchhaporla, MD, FACC

Dipti Itchhaporla, MD, FACC, is the ACC 70th president. Itchhaporla, an interventional cardiologist, is the Eric and Sheila Samson Endowed Chair in Cardiovascular Health, director of disease management for Hoag Heart and Vascular Institute, and associate professor at the University of California, Irvine, School of Medicine.

Itchhaporla has a long history of involvement and leadership with the College. In addition to serving on the Board of Trustees (BOT) as vice president and secretary, she was also chair of ACC's Board of Governors and president of ACC's California Chapter.

She has also served on ACC's Lifelong Learning Oversight Committee, Science and Quality Committee, Governance Committee, among others, and has also helped to inform ACC's Innovation Program efforts. Most recently, Itchhaporla chaired ACC's Task Force on Health Equity and served as co-chair of the ACC Middle East Conference in 2019 and 2020.

Itchhaporla is the College's first president of South Asian descent, and while she is the College's fifth female president, she is the first in College history to assume the presidency from another female president – ACC Immediate-Past President Athena Poppas, MD, MACC.

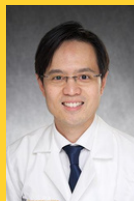
